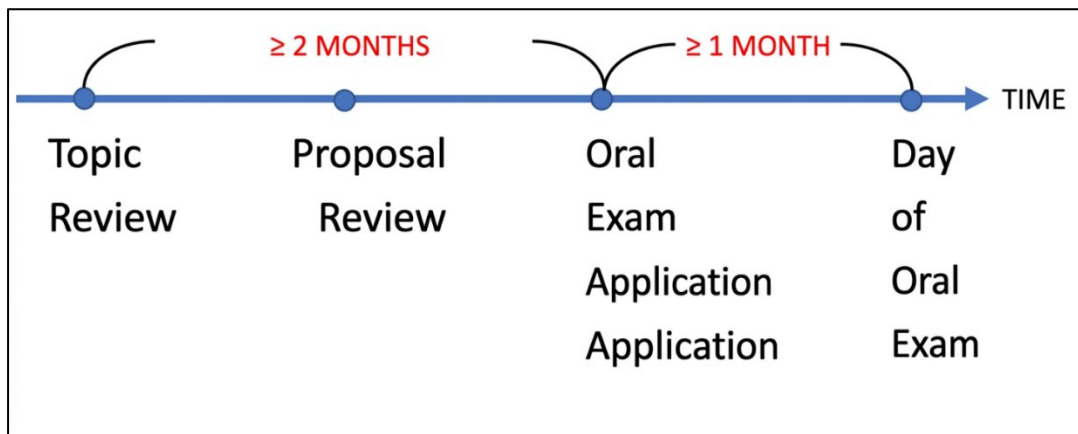


Q&A on the Master's Oral Defense Application Process for the Department of Computer Science and Information Engineering

1. Review of Master's Thesis Title (Including Abstract)

Q1: How long before applying for the oral defense should the topic review be submitted?

A1: Please submit it two months before applying for the oral defense.



Q2: Does the abstract have a specific format?

A2: No specific format.

Q3: If the topic has already been approved, is a re-review required if the topic is changed?

A3: Yes. Consequently, the defense date will also be postponed.

Q4: If the abstract is changed after the topic has been approved, is a re-review required?

A4: No.

Q5: Which teachers should conduct the topic review?

A5: Please ask your advisor to assist in inviting two full-time faculty members from the department to conduct the review.

2. Review of Master's Thesis Proposal (First Draft or First Three Chapters)

Q1: When should the proposal review be applied for?

A1: Please submit the application after your topic has been approved and before applying for the defense.

Q2: Is there a required format for the proposal (or the first three chapters)?

A2: No specific format. You may use the initial draft of your master's thesis or the first three chapters as the proposal.

Q3: If the proposal changes after the review, is a re-review required?

A3: No.

Q4: Do the reviewers for the proposal need to be the same as those for the topic review?

A4: Not necessarily. For the proposal review, please provide the "Topic Review Approval Form" as supporting evidence. If it has already been submitted to the department assistant, it is not required.

3. Applying for the Defense

Q1: When should the defense application be submitted?

A1: Please submit the application at least one month before the planned defense date.

Q2: Is there a required format for the poster to be prepared before the defense?

A2: Size A1 (same as the department's green poster stand). You may refer to examples, but it is recommended to design it yourself with a clean layout and clear fonts. The poster can be printed at the department office.

4. After Completing the Defense

Q1: After completing the defense, when can I receive my graduation certificate?

A1: Once your advisor approves and you obtain the "Approval Form," you can proceed with the departure procedures to receive your graduation certificate.
